

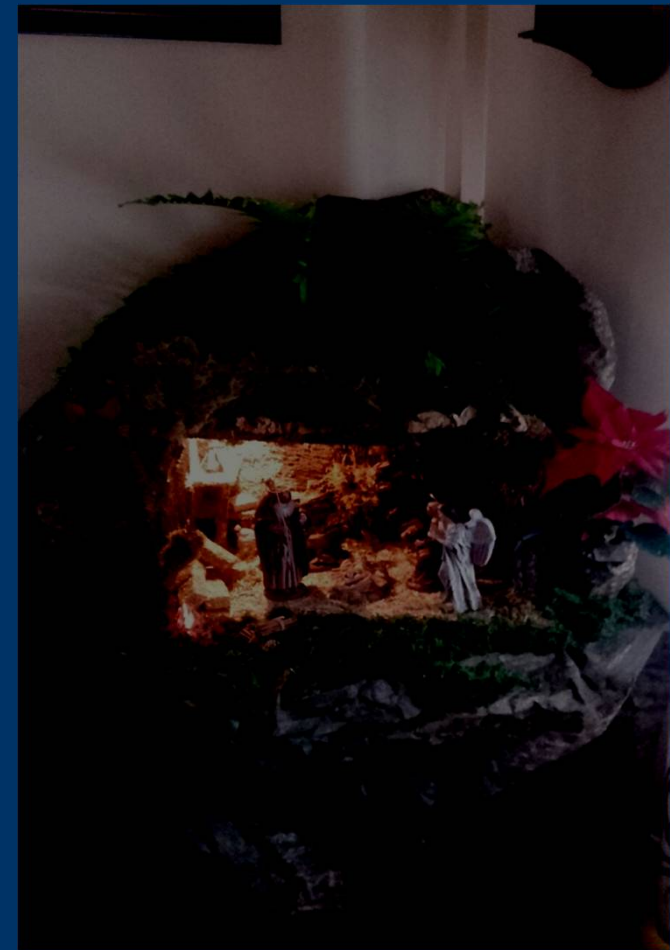
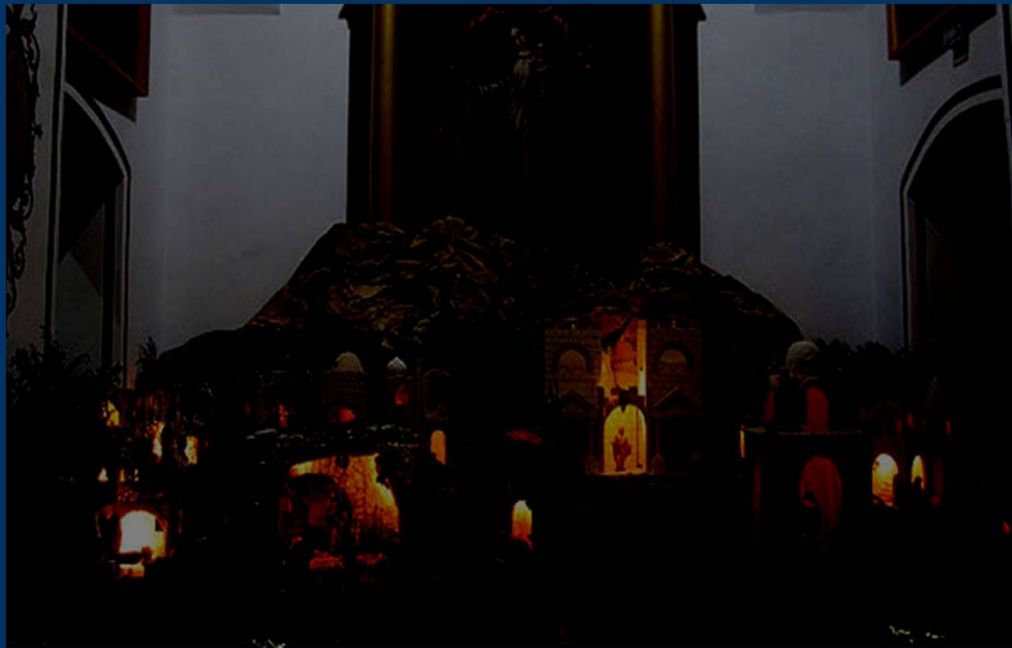

How fun is making friends!

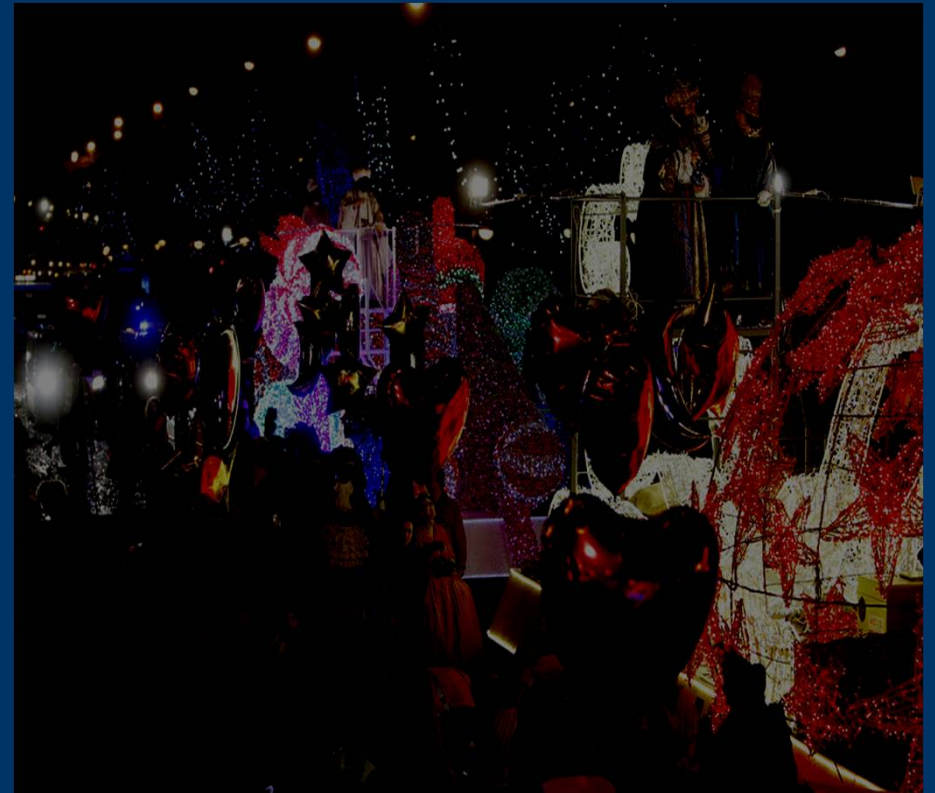
In Spain it is a tradition to make a Nativity scene, not only in churches but also in the houses.

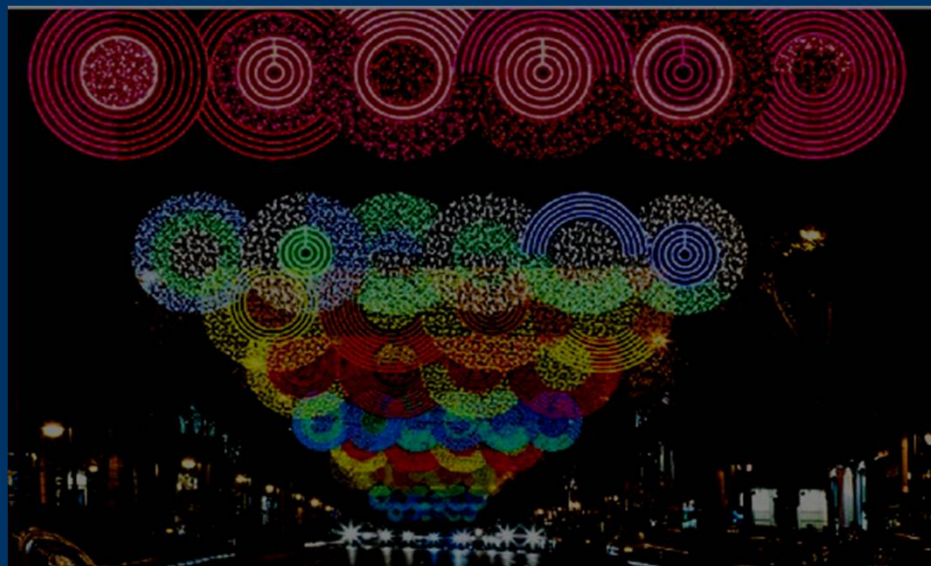
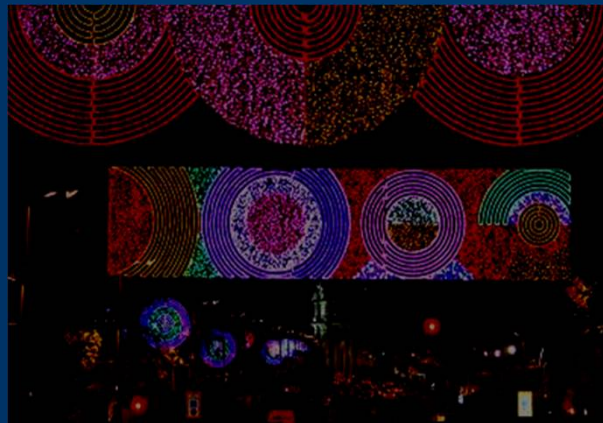
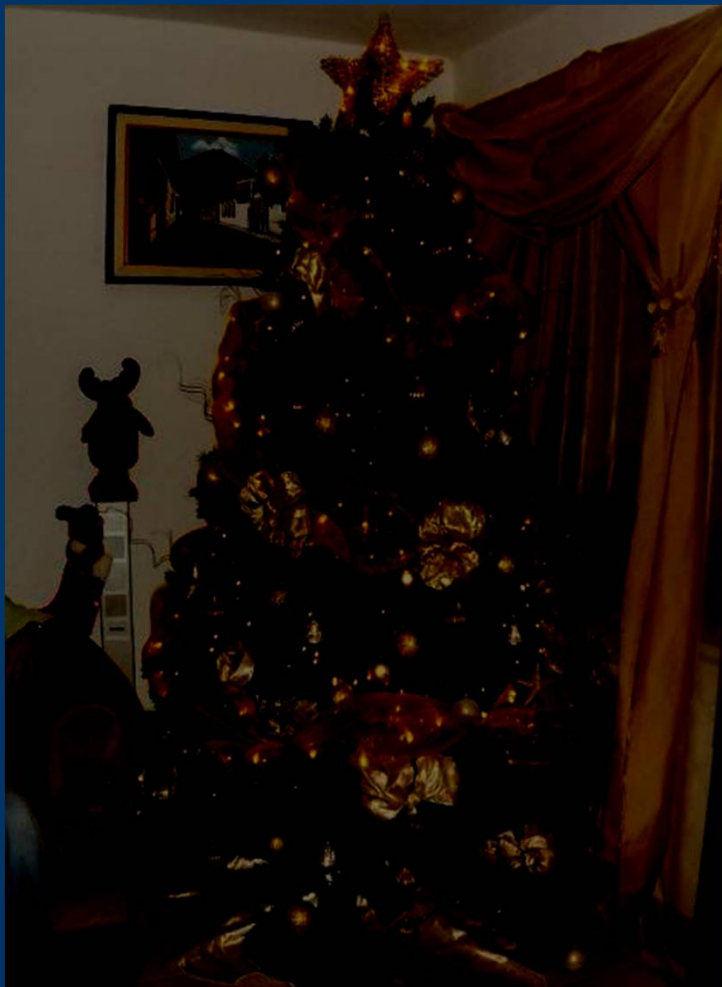
